Activities: Honor Society is an organization which emphasizes scholarship, character, leadership, and service and in the past we have taken on the following activities:

1. **America Reads-** Reading tutoring program for Muldown students—during lunch or your study hall
2. **Concessions**—The dates are: **Oct.2 (homecoming FB), Nov. 7 (FB, if played), Jan.2 (BBB), Jan. 23 (Speech & Debate; all day), Feb. 4 (BBB).**
3. **Community Christmas Lights:** The business community has come to depend on our help in preparing, setting up, and taking down the lights you see downtown. They need help on Wednesday, October 7th, and set up is usually on the Sunday before Thanksgiving (11/22); take down is usually the Sunday before Winter Carnival or in January.
4. **Academic Awards:** We sponsor the academic awards for students who earn a 4.0 GPA for the previous semester. Award programs will be held in April 6, 2010, 7 p.m.
5. **Induction Ceremony:** This is to induct the new members. The senior members are responsible for planning and carrying out the ceremony. This is on April 6, 2010, 7 p.m. in conjunction with academic awards.
6. **Academic Bowl**—Four teams face off to see which one comes out the academic winner. This will be held for an entire week during lunch in the library, usually in February.
7. **Peer Mentoring**—One-on-one homework tutoring during lunch, your study hall, or after school.
8. **Senior Breakfast-** Friday before graduation, June 4th. Last year sponsored and held at **Mountain West Bank.**
9. **Knowledge Master Open- Computerized** quiz of 200 questions done by a group after school, first week in December, by 12/2.
10. **Election of New Officers:** Nominations in April, voting in May.
